


SDUHSD Math Course Placement Recommendations 2018-19




- With an A grade in IMAE, we recommend enrollment in IMB which requires a summer bridge (pass/fail - requires attendance, not online/indep study). If student does not pass the summer bridge, then enroll in IMBE in 8th grade.
- With B or C grade in IMAE, students are eligible to complete a summer bridge (see above) and, if passed, enroll in IMB in 8th grade. This should be decided in consultation with the IMAE teacher, family, and counselor.
- With D or F in IMAE, student will be enrolled in IMBE in 8th grade.




- With an A grade in IMA, we recommend enrollment in IMB. If IMBH is a consideration, we strongly recommend consultation between IMA teacher and family before course selection. Test average data should be strongly considered in this consultation.
- With B or C grade in IMA, we recommend enrollment in IMB.
- Any student moving from IMA to IMBH is strongly encouraged to complete the independent study summer bridge.
- With D or F grade, the counselor, IMA teacher, and family consult to determine appropriate placement (IMB or IMBE).




- With A or B grade in IMAH, we recommend enrollment in IMBH.
- With C grade in IMAH, we strongly recommend enrollment in IMB.
- With D grade in IMAH, mandatory move to IMB.
- With F grade in 2nd semester IMAH, mandatory move to IMB.




- With an A grade in IMBE, we recommend enrollment in IM1 which requires a summer bridge (pass/fail - requires attendance, not online/indep study). If student does not pass the summer bridge, then enroll in IM1R in 9th grade.
- With B or C grade in IMBE, students are eligible to complete a summer bridge (see above) and, if passed, enroll in IM1 in 9th grade. This should be decided in consultation with the IMBE teacher, family, and counselor.
- With D or F in IMBE, student will be enrolled in IM1R in 9th grade.




- With an A grade in IMB, we recommend enrollment in IM1. If IM1H is a consideration, we strongly recommend consultation between IMB teacher and family before course selection. Test average data should be strongly considered in this consultation.
- With B or C grade in IMB, we recommend enrollment in IM1.
- Any student moving from IMB to IM1H is strongly encouraged to complete the independent study summer bridge.
- With D or F grade, the counselor, IMB teacher, and family consult to determine appropriate placement (IM1 or IM1R).




- With A or B grade in IMBH, we recommend enrollment in IM1H.
- With C grade in IMBH, we recommend enrollment in IM1.
- With D grade in IMBH, mandatory move to IM1.
- With F grade in 2nd semester IMBH, mandatory move to IM1.




- With A, B, or C grade in IM1R, we recommend enrollment in IM1.
- 9th graders with D or F grade in IM1R should repeat IM1R.
- 10th graders with D grade should enroll in IM1 (College Prep or Fundamental).
- Fundamental IM1 is only available to students with an IEP placement decision is made by IEP team with input from IM1R teacher and counselor.




- With an A grade in IM1, we recommend enrollment in IM2. If IM2H is a consideration, we strongly recommend consultation among IM1 teachers, family, & counselor before course selection. Test average data should be strongly considered in this consultation.
- Any student wishing to move from IM1 to IM2H must pass (pass/fail) the summer bridge.
- 9th/10th graders with B or C grades in IM1, we strongly recommend enrollment in IM2.
- 9th graders with D grade, we recommend repeating IM1.
- 10th graders with D grade, we recommend enrollment in IM 2/3 Essentials in 11th grade.
- Any student with F grade in IM1 is a mandatory repeat of IM1.
- Sped students who take IM1 (CP) and do not pass may consider Fundamental IM1.
 Fundamental IM1 is only available to students with IEP placement decision is made by IEP team with input from IM1 teacher and counselor.




- With A or B grade in IM1H, we recommend enrollment in IM2H.
- With C grade in IM1H, we recommend enrollment in IM2.
- With D grade in IM1H, we <u>strongly</u> recommend enrollment in IM2 (or repeat of IM1H).
- With F grade in IM1H, mandatory repeat of IM1H (or IM1, but won't replace IM1H grade).




- With an A grade in IM2, we recommend enrollment in IM3. If IM3H is a consideration, we strongly recommend consultation among IM2 teachers, family, & counselor before course selection. Test average data should be strongly considered in this consultation.
- Any student wishing to move from IM2 to IM3H must pass the summer bridge.
- With B or C grade in IM2, we recommend enrollment in IM3.
- With D grade in IM2, we recommend IM2 repeat, IM2/3 Essentials (Juniors only), or Business Math (Seniors only).
- With F grade, we recommend IM2 repeat, IM2/3 Essentials (Juniors only), or Business Math (Seniors only).




- With A or B grade in IM2H, we recommend enrollment in IM3H.
- With C grade in IM2H, we recommend enrollment in IM3.
- With D grade in IM2H, we strongly recommend enrollment in IM3.
- With F grade in IM2H, mandatory repeat of IM2H (or IM2, but won't replace IM2H grade).



- With A, B, or C in IM2/3 Essentials, we recommend enrollment in IM2, Business Math (Seniors only) or other Math Elective.
- With D/F in IM2/3 Essentials, we recommend enrollment in Business Math (Seniors only).
- If graduation credits are met, no math is required in subsequent year.
- If student previously passed IM2 & passes IM2/3 Essentials, then eligible for IM3.



- With A, B, C in IM3, we recommend enrollment in a College Prep Math Elective (Intro to Calc/Stats/AP Stats, etc.)
- Seniors may enroll in Business Math.
- If graduation credits are met, no math is required in subsequent year.



- With A or B in IM3H, we recommend enrollment in AP Calc, AP Stats, or other math elective.
- With C in IM3H, we recommend enrollment in a College Prep Math Elective such as Intro to Calc, Statistics, etc. We do not recommend enrollment in an AP math course.
- With D or F in IM3H, we recommend repeat of IM3H or Business Math (Seniors only).
- If graduation credits are met, no math is required in subsequent year.
