INSTRUCTIONS TO REGISTER FOR 8TH GRADE COURSES FOR CURRENT PTMS STUDENTS

Before beginning the registration process, please read this sheet carefully. There are two (2) steps to the registration process:

STEP 1:

The Course Selection Form is due to your history teacher by Wednesday, March 22nd 2017.

COURSE SELECTION FORM (Hard Copy) INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Please PRINT your last and first name **<u>neatly</u>**.
- 2. Students will automatically be placed in US History and 8th Grade Science.
- 3. Students are placed in the next course in the Math sequence. Please refer to the letter given to your student with this form or click on the link titled "SDUHSD 2016-17 to 2017-18 Math Course Transition" on the <u>Course Profiles and</u> <u>Descriptions</u> page on our website.
- 4. Students must take PE.
 - Students who take music may also enroll concurrently in ISPE to earn PE credit (ISPE Application required) and have the <u>option</u> to enroll in an additional elective.
 - If you want to take both PE and music, number PE as your Physical Education choice and number Band or Orchestra as your elective choice.
- 5. Students will have space in their class schedule for ONE YEAR-LONG ELECTIVE.
 - A World Language is not required for a high school diploma; however, two years are required to apply to a 4year university. At least one year needs to be taken at the high school for all years to count. (For example, you cannot take **just** Spanish I and II in 7th and 8th grade for it to count for college. You will need to take Spanish III in 9th grade for your middle school Spanish to count). You are advised to begin your language **by** 9thgrade. You will need to wait until high school if you wish to study French, Chinese, Japanese or Sign Language. These courses are not available at Pacific Trails but are available at the SDUHSD high schools.
 - o NOTE: Spanish II requires you to pass Spanish I prior to enrollment.
 - Please complete a Music Intent Form if you select Band or Orchestra. Applications are required for Leadership/ASB and Yearbook. All elective forms are online. Links to online forms are on the Pacific Trails website at <u>pt.sduhsd.net</u> under the Registration button.
- 6. Check the English class you would like to take. We strongly encourage you to review the English 8 and English 8 Honors Course Profiles to help guide your decision. English Course Profiles are available on the Pacific Trails Middle School's English Department website. There is a link from the Counseling page titled "Course Profiles and Descriptions".

A parent signature is required on the Course Selection Form.

STEP 2:

In addition to completing the Course Selection Form, you will go online and indicate your choices for **<u>English</u>**, **<u>PE & elective</u>**. The window for online selection will <u>open on March 14th and close on March22nd</u>.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTERING YOUR COURSE CHOICES ONLINE:

- 1. Go to the Pacific Trails website at http://pt.sduhsd.net/
- 2. Click on the Aeries icon on the bottom right of the home page and log in.
- 3. Click on "Student Info" and then click on "Course Requests Entry".
- 4. Click on "Search" under "Filter Courses". A new box will appear showing all of the courses offered at PTMS.
- 5. Select your courses by clicking on the course title. As you select courses, they will appear in the box to the left under "Current Requests".
- 6. If you change your mind, and need to remove a course, click on the red "x" button to remove the request.
- 7. Next to your elective choice, click on "Add Alternate" and enter your #2 elective choice
- 8. Make sure you select all of the classes you wish to take and check course titles.
