

Halloween Costume Guidelines for Monday, October 31st

Principal Nuskin and Assistant Principal Wood would like dressing up on Halloween at Pacific Trails to be a positive experience for all. All students must adhere to the following expectations:

- Costumes must conform to the Pacific Trails Middle School Dress Code (see website for details).
- Costumes may not be demeaning to any ethnic group, race, religion, nationality, disabilities, gender (boys as girls and vice versa), or individual (staff or student) at the school.
- Costumes may not cause a disruption or distraction to the school program, i.e. no skimpy or revealing costumes (French maids, nightwear, bathing suits, etc.).
- No weapons, toy weapons, or props replicating weapons are to be brought to school.
- No props or equipment that are unsafe.
- Costumes must not impair a student's vision or movement.
- Costumes may not show obscene materials or prohibited substances.
- No masks are permitted.
- If you are not sure, don't wear it! If you have questions, contact Principal Nuskin or Assistant Principal Wood.
- Although students may choose to wear glitter or different colored paint in their hair, spray cans are not allowed on campus.
