Dear Seventh Grade Parent/Guardian:

On Monday, March 6, your student will be receiving important information regarding how to make their 2023-24 course selections. In preparation for this task, our counselors will meet with all current seventh grade students to explain our course selection process. Course selection includes both an online selection and a hard copy contract. The window to select classes online will open on March 6 and close on March 13, 2023. Your student's 8th Grade Course Selection Contract is due back to the counseling office by either submitting via email to ptcourseselection@sduhsd.net or dropping it off in the counseling office. Students will sign up for English, and their elective choice. Students will automatically be enrolled in U. S. History, 8th Grade Science, Physical Education, and the next course in the math sequence. Please visit the counseling website for more information about course profiles and descriptions.

As mentioned, your child will be automatically enrolled in the next course in math per the SDUHSD course sequence table below. If this course differs from your choice, you will need to contact your student's counselor. If you have questions regarding your student's progress in math and want to discuss placement, your student's math teacher may also be a resource.
