PACIFIC TRAILS MIDDLE SCHOOL INSTRUCTIONS TO REGISTER FOR 8TH GRADE COURSES

There are two (2) steps to the Course Selection process:

STEP 1: COMPLETE THE COURSE SELECTION CONTRACT

The Course Selection Contract is due to your history teacher by March 13, 2020. Before completing the Course Selection Contract, please read these instructions carefully.

COURSE SELECTION INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS:

- 1. Please PRINT your last and first name **<u>neatly</u>** on the course selection contract.
- 2. Students will automatically be placed in US History and 8th Grade Science.
- 3. Students are placed in the next course in the Math sequence. Please refer to the letter given to your student with this form or click on the link titled "SDUHSD Math Course Sequences" on the <u>Course Profiles and Descriptions</u> page on our website.
- 4. Check the English class you would like to take. We strongly encourage you to review the English 8 and English 8 Honors Course Profiles to help guide your decision. English Course Profiles are available on the Pacific Trails Middle School's English Department website. There is a link from the Counseling page titled "Course Profiles and Descriptions".
- 5. All students will automatically be placed in Physical Education.
 - If you would like to apply for Independent Study Physical Education (ISPE) or need additional information, please visit the <u>SDUHSD ISPE Website</u>. All students who wish to enroll in ISPE are required to complete the mandatory district application. The ISPE application window opens Monday, February 10, 2020 and the deadline is Friday, April 3, 2020 @ 3:00 PM. Students are not permitted to stay on campus during their assigned ISPE period.
 - Students who take a year-long instrumental music class may also apply to take ISPE concurrently to earn PE credit (ISPE Application required). This allows instrumental music students the option to take a second elective. If you are requesting to take both ISPE and music, mark your selection on the Course Selection Contract.

6. Students will have space in their class schedule for ONE YEAR-LONG ELECTIVE.

<u>Rank in order (1 through 4) your elective choices</u> with number 1 being your first choice. Please remember that all classes are year-long at PTMS. We try our best to honor your 1st or 2nd choice. For a brief description of courses, please refer to the Course Profiles and Descriptions located on the Counseling page of the PTMS website: pt.sduhsd.net.

- Spanish 1 NOTE: Students must pass Spanish 1 prior to enrolling in Spanish 2. World Language is not required for a SDUHSD high school diploma; however, 2 years are required to apply to most 4-year colleges. Students may wait until high school to begin language courses which are not offered at PTMS. Spanish is the only World Language offered at PTMS. We recommend that most students begin a language other than English by 9th or 10th grade.
- Please complete a Music Intent Form if you select Band or Orchestra. The Music Intent form is on the Pacific Trails website at <u>pt.sduhsd.net</u> under the Registration button. See "Elective Registration Applications."
- Applications are required for Leadership/ASB and Yearbook. All elective forms are online. Links to online forms are on the Pacific Trails website at <u>pt.sduhsd.net</u> under the Registration button. See "Elective Registration Applications."

7. <u>A parent and student signature are required on the Course Selection Contract.</u>

STEP 2: SELECT YOUR CLASSES ONLINE

In addition to completing the Course Selection Contract, you will go online and indicate your choices for English & an Elective Course ONLY. The window for online selection will open on March 5 and close on March 13.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTERING YOUR COURSE CHOICES ONLINE:

- 1. Go to the Pacific Trails website at http://pt.sduhsd.net/
- Click on the Aeries icon on the bottom right of the home page and log in.
- 3. Click on "Classes" and then click on "Course Requests Entry".
- 4. Click on "Search" under "Filter Courses". A new box will appear showing the courses offered at PTMS.
- 5. Select your courses by clicking on the course title. Once a course has been requested, it will display on the left side of the Course Request Entry page in the Course Requests area.
- 6. If you change your mind, and need to remove a course, click on the red "x" button to remove the request.
- 7. Next to your elective choice, click on "Add Alternate" and enter your #2 elective choice.
- 8. Make sure you select all of the classes you wish to take and check course titles.

- No schedule changes will be made to accommodate any off- campus, extracurricular or athletic activities.
- Courses may be cancelled due to insufficient enrollment or staffing restrictions.
- SDUHSD Board Policy sets a 4 week limit at the beginning of each semester to drop a class without it reflecting on the transcript. English and math level changes may be requested during this four-week period if there is space available.
