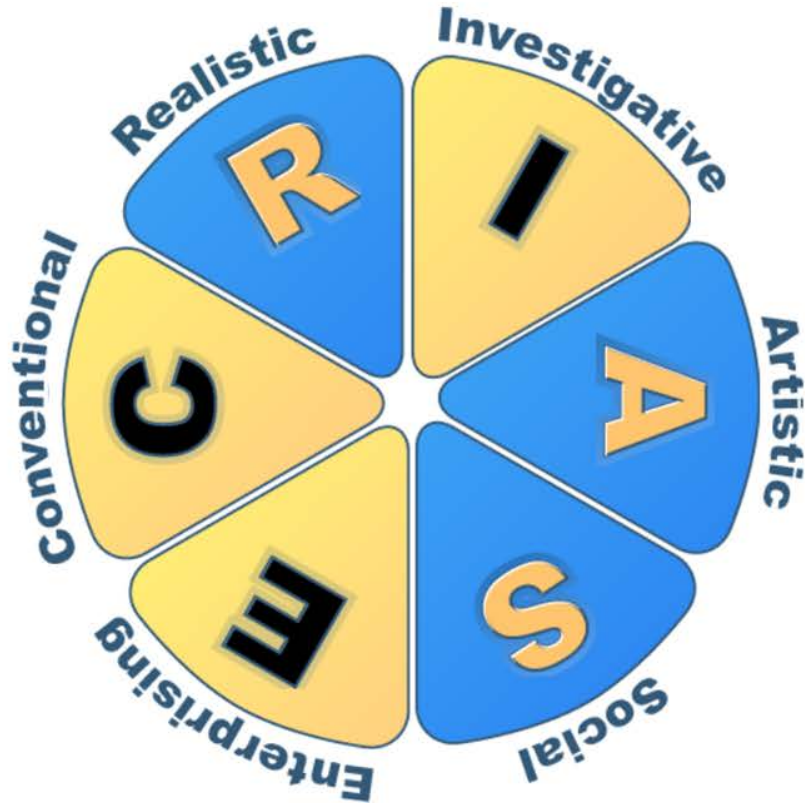

Interest Profiler :: Summary
