


- Middle school is a time when students make tremendous GROWTH in their learning

What if I don't have an Aeries account?

- Ask your parents if they have the Aeries letter that was mailed in the spring
- If they do, use the instructions to set up a <u>student</u> account
- If you do not have the letter at home, see Ms. Mona in the Counseling Office and you can get a copy of the letter with instructions

How to Email Your Teachers from San Dieguito Tech Academy

- 1. Don't use email for something that can be addressed in person
 - If you have a question about the homework, check the website first or call a study buddy first. Use your resources!
- 2. Be formal
 - Use complete sentences.
 - Use capital letters and appropriate language
 - No text language or short-cuts
 - Use "please" and "thank you"

How to Email Your Teachers (con't)

- 3. Use an email account with a formal name and has your name in it (if possible)
 - If your email doesn't have your name in it and you don't sign the email, your teacher won't know who sent it to him/her!
- 4. Include a meaningful subject line
- 5. Always use a greeting ex: Dear Mrs. Curry
- 6. Briefly and politely state the reason why you are emailing
- 7. If you are emailing with a problem, try to suggest a solution
- 8. Reread and proofread what you have written before you hit send. (spellcheck)
- 9. Allow adequate time for a reply (24 hours)

Tips for Success

- Be on time for class
- If I'm absent, how do I find out what I've missed?
 - Ask a friend
 - Checking the teacher's website
 - Check Aeries
 - Many teachers post their assignments for the week on the whiteboard
