Course Selection for 8th Grade

- You will be selecting:
 - English
 - PE
 - Elective
 - All students will be automatically enrolled in US History, 8th Grade Science and the next course in the math sequence.
- Step 1: The 8th Grade Course Selection Contract must be completed and is due to your history teacher by Friday, March 22nd.
 - Before you begin to fill out the Course Selection Contract, read it. It is a contract because your signature will indicate that you understand it and that you will abide by it.
- Step 2: Log into (with your parents) your Aeries Parent Portal account. Students will select their courses ONLINE! The online registration window will be open on March 14th and will close on March 22nd.

- Understands how to take notes and follow directions without prompting.
- Has well developed organizational skills.
- Talks analytically about literature and stories outside of the classroom.
- Appreciates an accelerated pace and workload in and outside of the classroom.
- Enjoys leading discussions within the classroom.
- Is a self-directed learner who find joy in exploring more outside of the classroom.

ISPE

While our primary recommendation is that all students participate in the district physical education program, we do offer an independent study physical education program for:

- (1) individualized sports only (no team sports)
- (2) students are accepted on a case by case basis
- (3) music students may apply for ISPE as a 7th class and choose a second elective.
- (4) students who participate in a minimum of an average of 400 minutes every two weeks in their individual sport
- Note: The window to apply for 2019–20 begins **April 15, 2019**. The deadline is **May 31, 2019**.

- Begin your world language no later than 9th grade.
- In 9th grade, additional choices of French, Japanese, Chinese and American Sign Language may be available (depending on which high school you attend).

Looking ahead – UC/CSU A-G Subject Requirements

- ▶ A History/Social Science: 2 years
- **B** English: 4 years
- C Math (including Integrated Math 1,2,3): 3 years *4 years recommended
- D Lab Science: 2 years *3 years recommended
- ▶ E Language other than English: 2 years *3 years recommended
- ▶ F Visual or Performing Arts: 1 year
- ▶ **G** College Prep Elective: 1 year

Choose Wisely

- We are scheduling for the whole year.
- Schedule changes will not be made to accommodate teacher requests, classes with friend requests, period requests, or extracurricular and athletic activities.
- SDUHSD Board Policy sets a four-week limit at the beginning of each semester to drop a class. Level changes (from honors to college prep) may be requested during this four-week period if there is space available.

Step 4: A new screen will appear showing all courses offered at PTMS.






