- Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS)
 - shifting the focus from the memorization of facts to greater student engagement in the processes of science.
- The NGSS emphasizes learning in three dimensions:
 - The Science and Engineering Practices
 - Crosscutting Concepts
 - Disciplinary Core Ideas.
- The shifts in instruction include:
 - the interconnected nature of science as practiced in the real world
 - the integration of science and engineering
 - the use of performance expectations
 - a focus on deeper understanding of content as well as application of content, and alignment to the Common Core State Standards.
