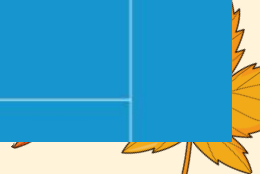



Club Spotlight: Future Doctors of America

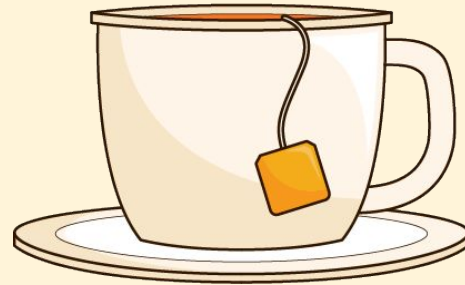
