

PTMS is once again taking part in No Place For Hate.


This is a program created by the Anti-Defamation League that helps schools become a more tolerant and welcoming place for everyone.

The Athlete who went by "Taffy" was a professional ice hockey player for the New York Rangers and Chicago Black Hawks in the National Hockey League. Born in 1900 in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan, United States, as a Native American Ojibwe, he was forced to hide his Native American ancestry until 1939. Indigenous Peoples Day was celebrated on October 10, 2022


