Hispanic Heritage Feature: Dr. Ellen Ochoa

Hispanic Heritage Month is September 15-October 15



Meet Dr. Ellen Ochoa, born May 10, 1958 in California. She is the first Hispanic astronaut to go into space on a nine-day mission aboard the space shuttle Discovery. She went into space four times. Dr. Ellen Ochoa was the second female and the first Hispanic director of the Johnson Space Center. She was also the first Latina astronaut to be in the Hall of Fame. Ochoa has been recognized with NASA's highest award, the Distinguished Service Medal, and the Presidential Distinguished Rank Award.
