
As you return to the hotel there are four other contestants. All the contestants are grown adults where you are just a teenager. Do you drop out and accept defeat or compete with the low probability to win?

Kwanzaa

- ❖ Kwanzaa is a 7 day holiday celebrated from December 26-January 1
- ❖ Each day is represented by one of the seven holiday principles: Unity, self-determination, collective responsibility, cooperative economics, purpose, creativity, faith
- ❖ The symbols of Kwanzaa are: candleholder, unity cup, placemat, crops, corn, and gifts.
- ❖ The 7 candles are often colored red, green and black
- ❖ It's not considered a religious holiday
